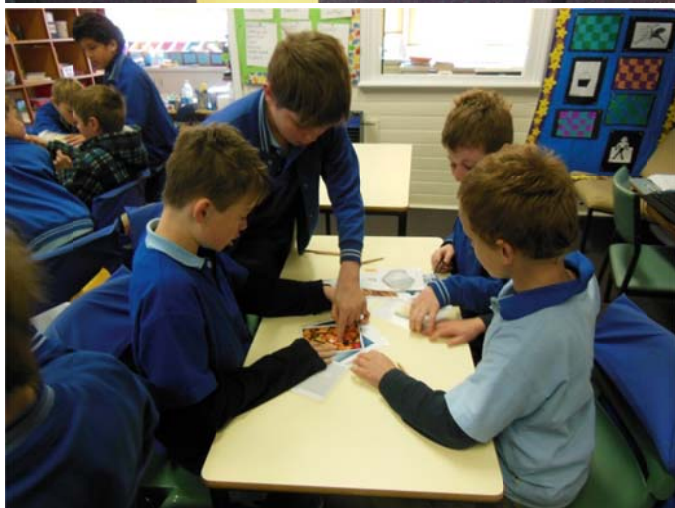
## Waste Education

Today the 3-6 class had a visit from Amie-Lea Friend who is Goulburn Mulwaree Council's Waste Education Officer.

Amie taught the students about food wastage and the resources, including fuel, energy and water that are wasted in the process. The students learnt how scrapping leftovers into the bin directly contributes to climate change. The students learnt about the life cycle of an organic food product, growing food at home, reading a recipe, measuring ingredients and composting to reduce environmental damage.

This visit and the learning acquired complemented the work being done in class regarding composting. Our school is working towards separate bins in the playground for general litter, recyclable litter and green waste. The 3-6 class have been designing labels for these bins to identify what to throw into them. Green waste will be taken to the

compost bay and later used on the vegetable garden.



Mr Grainger is also getting in on all things eco gardening. He is currently making us a net covering structure for each of our garden beds to keep rabbits etc out.
