### **Community Coach Training Day**

Our Active After School program has been sustainable because of the wonderful parents who have completed the training and fulfilled a seven session stint this year as an after school coach. Some of the sports that have been part of our program have been cricket, tennis, basketball, soccer and hockey.

If you have a particular sport you may be skilled in, or if you enjoy sport in general, why not consider attending our community coach training day on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2014 here at school starting at 11am and become a community coach for Tallong Public School. Prior coaching experience is not necessary.

This is a paid position with coaches receiving approx. \$40 each afternoon for 7 consecutive weeks in a term. We only ask you to commit to one term in any year but you are welcome to do more if you wish and a teacher is with you throughout the session to provide supervision and manage student behaviour.

Comprehensive resources are provided to you as a result of training and the school provides all necessary equipment.
