CANTEEN Routines

Late Arrivals / Early Departures

If your child arrives late to school, please visit the office with your child to receive a late arrival note. This note must then be handed to the classroom teacher as you deliver your child to the classroom.

If you need to pick up your child before 3pm, please visit the office first to sign your child out, then go and collect your child from the classroom, handing the teacher the early departure note.

If there is no one in the office, please visit Mrs Matthews classroom where there is also a sign in/sign out register.

These systems can be a little tedious but they are very important in regard to our record keeping and to ensure your child is safe.

Active After School's Community Coaching

We require parents to volunteer to become an after school coach for our Tuesday and Wednesday clubs. Whilst some parents approached me last year expressing a willingness to be involved, we are still looking for more volunteers. Coaches are paid and the total commitment is of 7 weeks duration.

A coach training session is being run on **Saturday 16th February**, at Tallong School, between 10am – 4pm. This course qualifies community members to coach our after school sessions being paid \$40 per afternoon.

HEAD LICE

It seems as though the head lice also know it is “Back to School” time. We have had a few reported cases and it would help greatly if all parents could check their child/ren’s hair for nits/lice.

How can you get rid of head lice? Daily combing using white hair conditioner with a fine-tooth comb is effective in getting rid of head lice and eggs (nits).

How can you help reduce the spread of head lice?

- Regularly check your children's hair.
- Teach older children to check their own hair.
- Tie back and braid long hair.
- Keep a fine-tooth head lice comb in the bathroom and encourage all family members to use it when they wash their hair.
