We have been working hard to ensure the technology we have is ready to support our students in this trial test. Please remember that it is just that, a trial, and there will be no published results. It is the technology, the platform, and how students work online that is being analysed. Students will not be able to practise for the test beforehand.

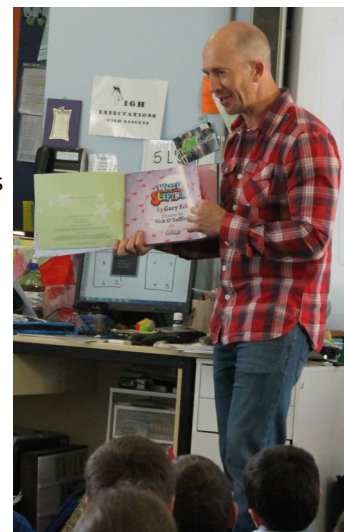

We have launched a new online payment portal linked to our Tallong Public School website to make it easier for you to deposit school related payments. This is a secure payment page hosted by Westpac Bank.

What expenses can be paid online?

Voluntary Contributions, Subject Contributions, Excursions, Sport, Other.

How?

Log onto the School site at: www.tallong-p.school.nsw.edu.au

Click on "Make a Payment" and follow the prompts to make a payment via Visa or MasterCard.

It is important to remember that transactions will take a day or two to be processed.

Signed permission notes are to be returned to school when online payment has been completed, with a transaction receipt number.

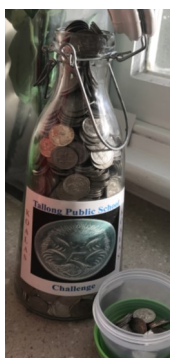

Last chance to order summer school uniforms. Please hand in order form tomorrow morning if you require any uniforms for summer.

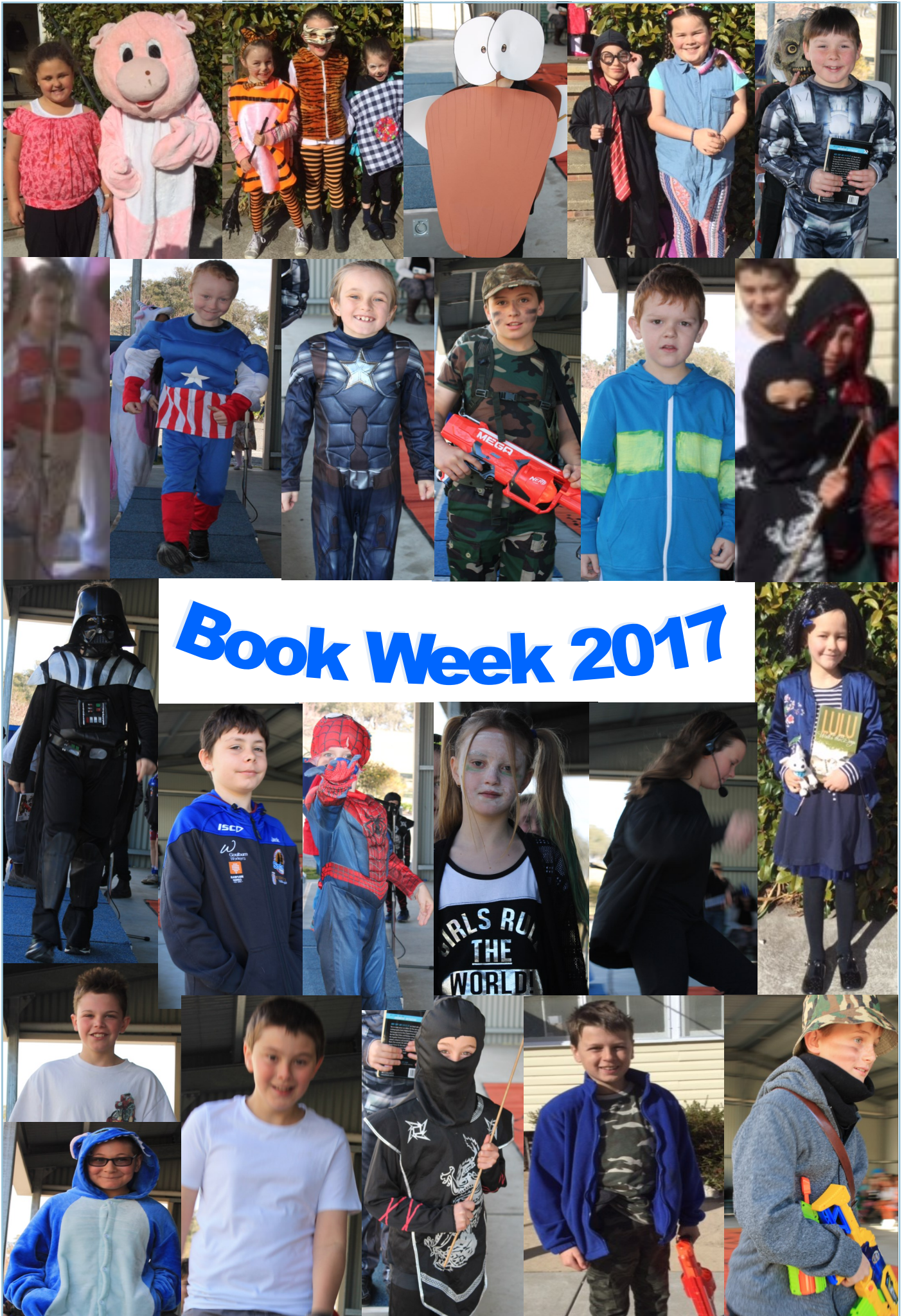
