Dear Parents/Carers,

Congratulations to Mrs Cox-Barlow for completing her Anti Racist Contact Officer (ARCO) course this week. Under the Department's Anti-Racism Policy each school is required to have a trained Anti-Racism Contact Officer.

#### What is the role of the ARCO

The Anti-Racism Contact Officer does not investigate complaints of racism. The ARCO has a mediation, procedural, educational and monitoring role.

Any concerns held by parents/carers or students regarding racism should be directed to the principal who will consult with the ARCO.

#### 2018 Enrolments

We continue to grow in enrolments and at this point in time, our enrolments for 2018 will be 71 students, which is just 7 short of a fourth classroom teacher entitlement, (enrolment of 78 students entitles a school to a 4<sup>th</sup> classroom teacher). Our three-year strategic plan 2018-2020 is all the more relevant as we consider future resources for our growing school.
