I hope everyone has an enjoyable and safe holiday. Mrs Moore will be back on Day 1 of next term and I know she is looking forward to catching up with everyone's news.

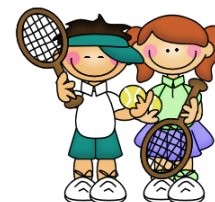

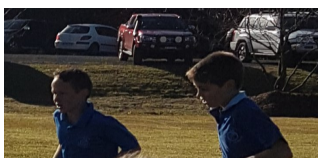
