### **SELECTIVE HIGH SCHOOL APPLICATIONS FOR 2021**

- 8 October 2019 Application for entry in 2021 opens online
- 11 November 2019 Application for entry in 2021 closes. Late applications will not be accepted.
- All applicants are required to sit the Selective High School Placement Test to be held on Thursday 12 March 2020.


