#### NATIONAL DAY OF ACTION AGAINST BULLY-ING AND VIOLENCE

#### **HARMONY WEEK**

Tallong's Harmony Week will culminate with Friday's Harmony Day planned activities with the students invited to wear orange.

#### 'TELL THEM FROM ME' Survey

This term, our school, like many other public schools in the state, will participate in a Department of Education initiative: the 'Tell Them From Me' student feedback survey. The survey measures factors that are known to affect academic achievement and other student outcomes.

The focus of the NSW wide survey is on student wellbeing, engagement and effective teaching practices. More information about the survey is available at: http://surveys.cese.nsw.gov.au The survey is a great opportunity for our Years 4-6 students to provide us with valuable and guick feedback on what they think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them. Schools in Australia and around the world have used the 'Tell Them From Me survey' to help improve how they do things at school. The survey is confidential, is conducted online and will typically take less than 30 minutes to complete. It will be administered during school hours towards the end of this term. Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary. A consent form for parents/carers about the survey has been sent home with students. #### TERM ACCOUNT


Just a friendly reminder about our Term 1 Account and outstanding fees. Our school cross country is next week and that was listed on the account.


